## General Rules for Photo-taking at <a href="#">Chinese Temples Committee Administered Temples</a>

1. Application for photo-taking must be submitted to the Chinese Temples Committee in writing (by mail or by fax) for consideration and approval. Address and fax number are as follows:

- 2. Application will normally take <u>7 working days</u> to process. The written application should include the following information:
- a. Proposed date and time of photo-taking
- b. Number of participants
- c. Name of Applicant (Individual / Company / Organization)
- d. Purpose of the photo-taking
- 3. Photos taken can only be used for academic research, promotion of knowledge, news release or educational purposes. Any photo-taking for commercial purpose will NOT be approved;
- 4. Close up shot of any statues inside the temple is prohibited;
- 5. To protect the privacy of worshippers, photo-taking of worshippers' worshipping activities is NOT allowed;
- 6. The Chinese Temples Committee is NOT liable for dispute with third parties arising from the photo-shooting activities;
- 7. The applicant agrees to indemnify and keep indemnified the Chinese Temples Committee against all losses and damages arising from the photo-shooting activities.
- 8. Undue disturbances to the worshippers, the temple keeper or the

operation of the temple is NOT allowed;

- 9. No photo-shooting in areas not open to public;
- 10. The Chinese Temples Committee reserves the copyright and ownership of the photos taken;
- 11. An acknowledgement to the Chinese Temples Committee is required when releasing the photos.
